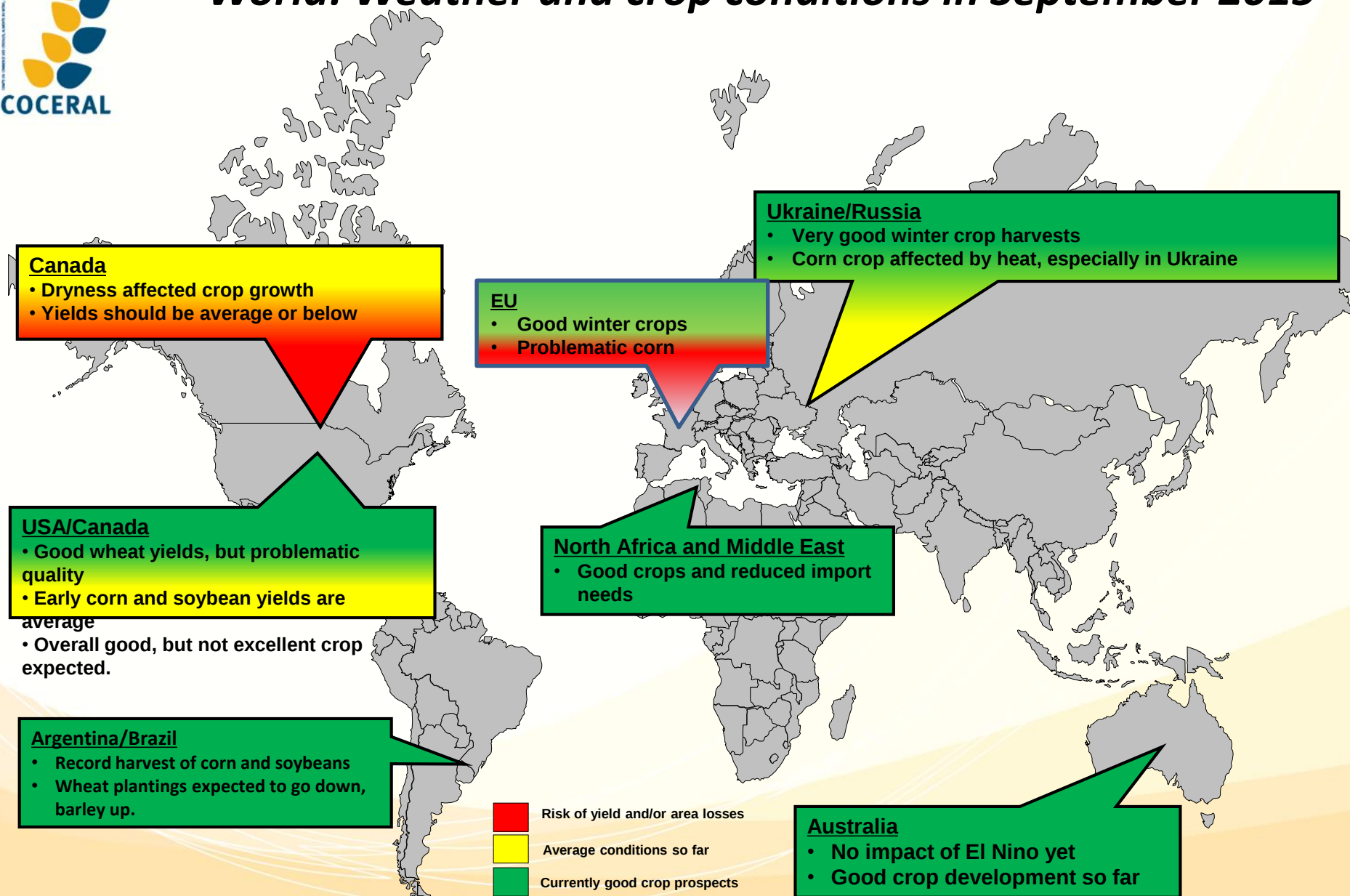

World: Weather and crop conditions in September 2015



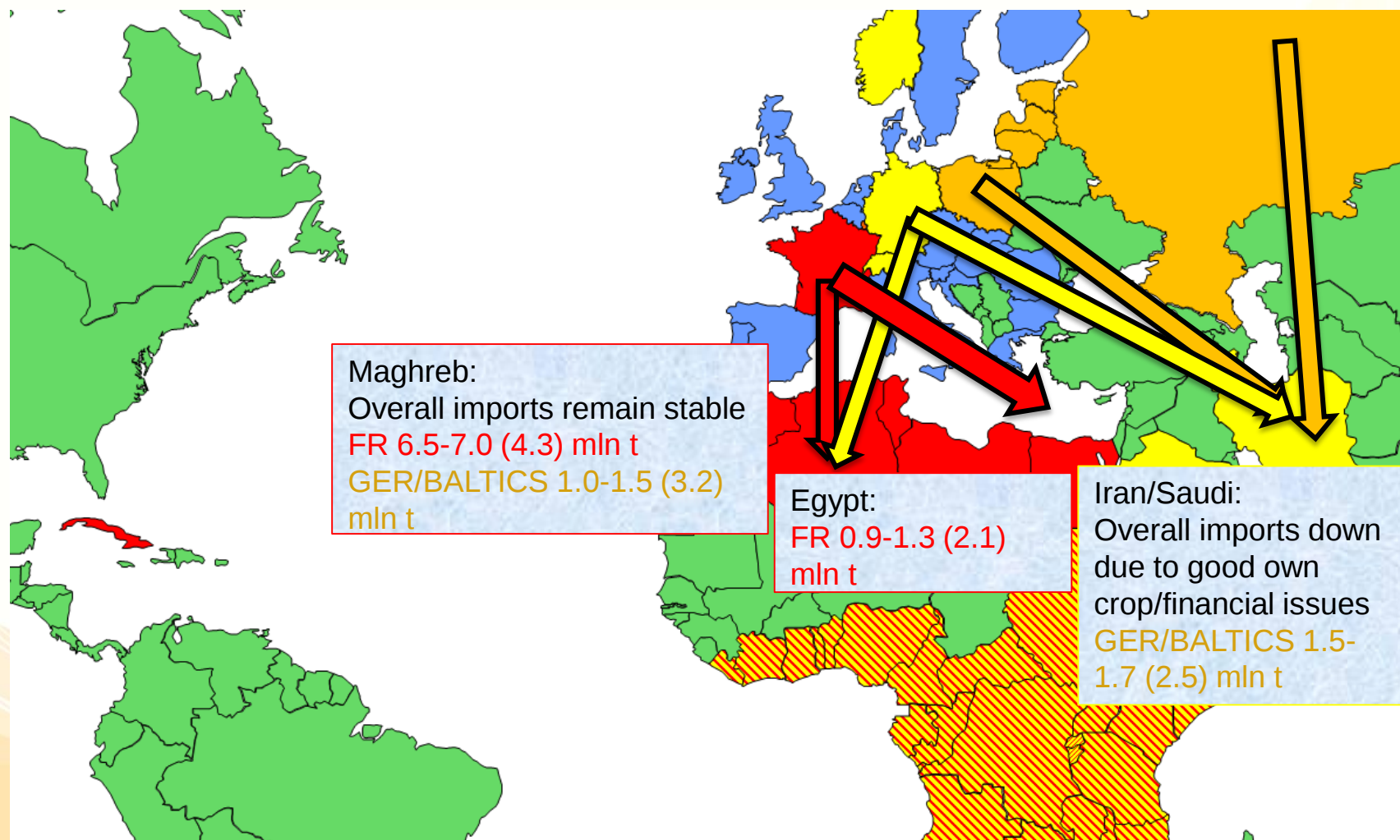

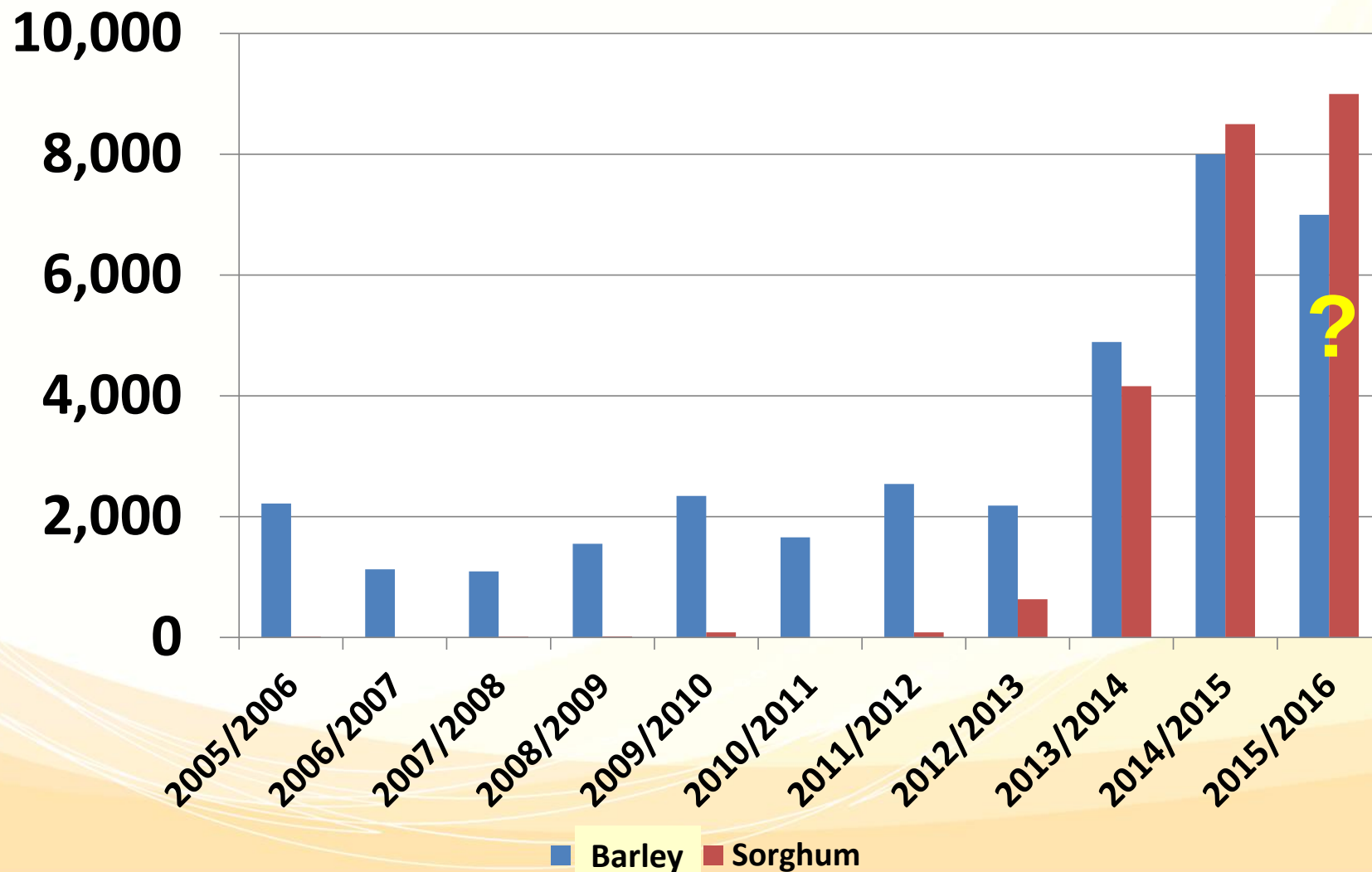
NEW COCERAL crop forecasts release on 25th September

EU sees lower demand from key destinations in North Africa and Middle East. Germany will suffer, France not.

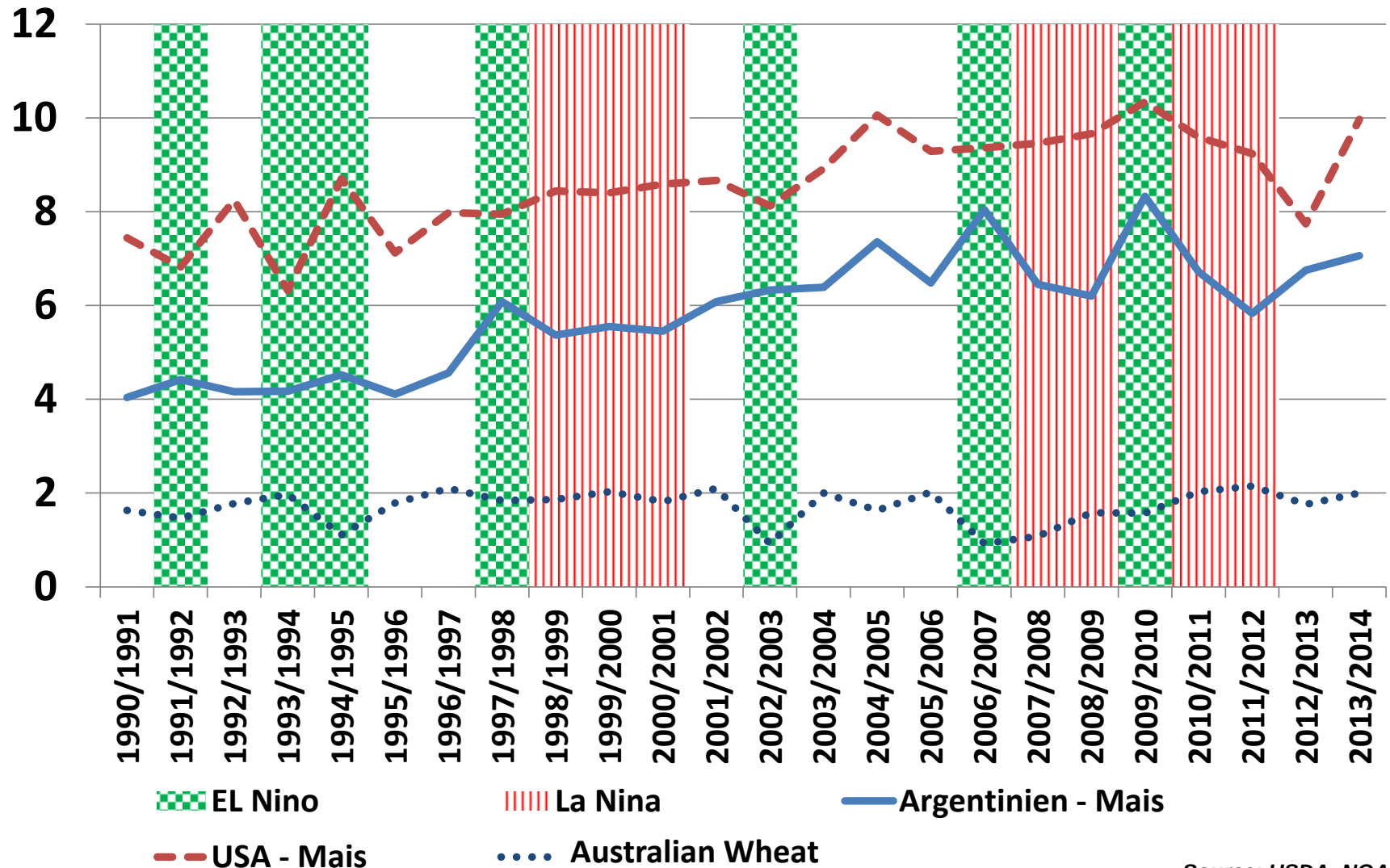


China: Barley and sorghum imports (mln t)



El Nino

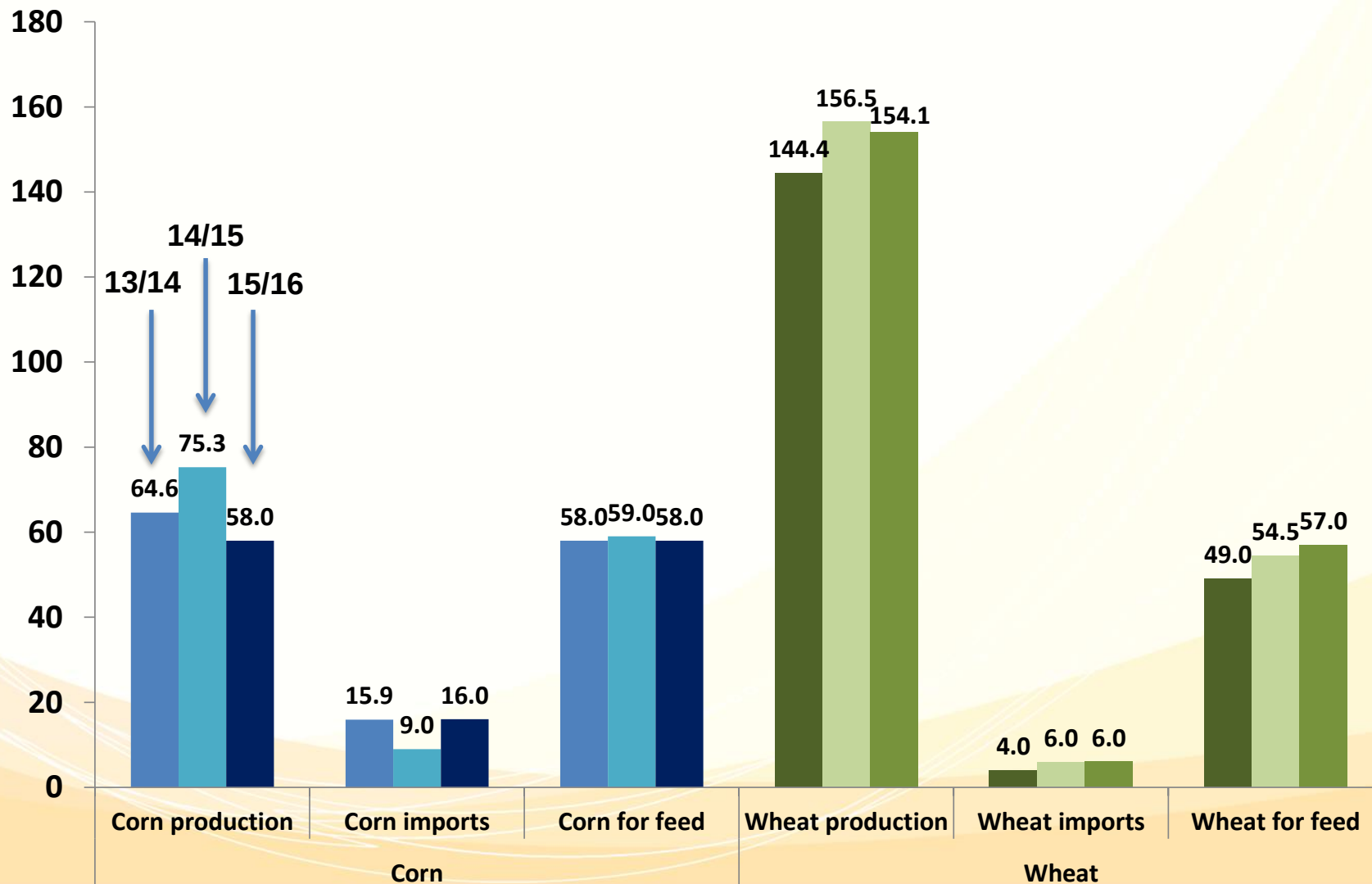
Seems to be likely again - good crops in SA, low in Aussie
